The radiators have been moved. The painting is complete. The sound system is getting updated and the carpet has been ordered. For me personally, it has been very interesting to watch what seemed like an immense project get broken down into parts, tackled by experts in their fields and completed so efficiently and so quickly. I can't wait to see the finished product.

We do have some pews that need to find new homes quickly.
