



## Mt. Olivet Cemetery Association

The Mt. Olivet Cemetery Association is a non-profit organization offering a beautiful and peaceful resting place for you and your loved ones. Our 11 acre cemetery allows for a quiet and serene atmosphere to visit and honor the deceased. The Cemetery's financial condition and prudent management ensures that the grounds will be maintained in perpetuity.

We encourage those making burial or pre-planning arrangements to visit our grounds and select a spot. A personal visit is the best way to become familiar with the various areas of the Cemetery. Please contact the church office to schedule your visit.

We offer traditional ground burial plots, including vault and urn plots that allow you to express and honor a life lived. We offer a variety of size and cost options to create a loving memorial as follows:

- \$1,000 - 4' X 10' Single Plot
  - \$2,000 - 8' X 10' Double Plot
  - \$500 - 4' X 4' Cremation Plot
- (\*Mt. Olivet Church members receive a 25% discount on plots.)

Burial fees at the time of burial include opening, closing, seeding and lawn care and are as follows:

- \$1,000 - 4' X 10' Opening & Closing
- \$450 - Cremation Opening & Closing

Note: Seeding will be approximately 10-12 months after closing to allow proper settling of the soil.

Certain decorations are permitted; however, we do have some restrictions on decorations that would detract from the Cemetery's appearance or inhibit maintenance. Fall and winter artificial grave decorations are permitted from October 1 to March 14th. On March 15 of each year, we remove all decorations for a general cleanup. On October 1, we remove all fresh flowers and plants. Please contact the church office for a complete set of cemetery rules.
